Join the Volunteer List!

Attend School Council meetings.

The council typically meets six times per year, and meetings are advertised in advance on Newswire. Any member of the school community is welcome to attend any meeting to participate in the discussion, although you will not be a voting member.

Join School Council as a Member-at-Large.

This gives you voting privilege at any meeting which you chose to attend, and the opportunity to join sub-committees of the council. To become a member-at-large, simply attend the first Council meeting on September 11 at 6:30pm and forms will be made available for you to register.
